

Friends of Cherry Point APPLICATION FOR CIVILIAN BASE ACCESS Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point

> Sound of Freedom Golf Course ONLY

READ THIS FIRST SAVE FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Sound of Freedom Golf Course is a Department of Defense (DoD) golf course located on a military instillation. The Friends of Cherry Point (FOCP) program allows restricted access for civilian golfers to the Sound of Freedom Golf Course ONLY.

Base access is a privilege and may be revoked or denied. A background check will be run prior to approval and negative findings will result in access denial. **Inappropriate behavior is grounds for denial or revocation of access.**

All new and renewal requests must follow the procedures below;

1. Applications may be sent in by **fax** (252-466-8096), **mail** (*Review & Analysis Office*, PSC Box 8009, Marine Corps Air Station, Cherry Point, NC 28533-0009) or **hand delivered** (to golf course or Building 400) by those with access. The application on the following page must be completed for consideration. All personal information will be kept confidential and protected under the terms of the Privacy Act.

2. If approved for access to Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS), Cherry Point, the applicant will go to the Pass & ID office at the Main Gate. Security will conduct an interview where conditions and restrictions of base access are reviewed and the applicant is asked to sign a form indicating agreement to the terms and conditions of access.

The following documents are required when arriving at security;

- a. Social Security Card or Verification Letter from the Social Security Administration
- b. **REAL ID** or acceptable alternative form of identification
- c. Vehicle Registration and Proof of Insurance.

Passes will be shown to the officer at the gate upon arrival. All passengers within a vehicle MUST have their own passes. FOCP members must immediately proceed to the Golf Course. When use of the facility is completed, members must directly exit the base. <u>Any deviation from this route may result in the loss of base entry privileges.</u>

All personnel and their property are subject to search while gaining access to or on MCAS. Seat belts must be worn at all times while on base. Using a cellular phone while driving is strictly prohibited. Have your pass and ID on your person and be prepared to present it when asked. Always stop for pedestrians. All personnel must follow Marine Corps policies while on base including, but not limited to, ASO 5560.6B Installation Access and ASO 5560.7A Motor Vehicle Traffic Regulations.
