

Language Competency - Available EVERY 2nd and 4th Wednesday of Month at 0800

Defense Language Aptitude Battery (DLAB): Computer based test used to measure the ability to learn a foreign language (90 minutes).

Defense Language Prociency Test (DLPT): Listening and reading tests designed to determine foreign language proficiency (180 minutes each).

Oral Proficiency Inventory (OPI) - By appointment only: One-on-one phone interview between a certified ACTFL tester and the examinee. Used to assess spoken language proficiency (20-30 minutes).

Military Competency - Available EVERY Wednesday at 0800

Armed Forces Classification Test (AFCT): Required when military personnel want to change career fields and do not currently have a qualifying score for the career moves.


Aviation Selection Test Battery (ASTB): The primary test used by the U.S. Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard in the selection of officer aviation program applicants.

DOD FIRE and Emergency - Available EVERY Thursday at 1000

Career Development Courses (CDC): Computer based exams for DoD Fire and Emergency services employees used to evaluate career development competency.

The MCAS Cherry Point National Testing Center is CLOSED every Friday.


