Initial:	3. Not all languages qualify for FLPB. Marines experiencing FLPB problems must utilize their Chain-of-Command IPAC, Admin Office, Career Planner, 1st SGT, or S-1.				
Initial:	4. Unofficial scores can be provided at the testing center for Language tests and DLAB immediately following test completion				
Initial:	5. E-5 and below must obtain authorization from his/her command. (E-6 and above can sign request form)

Eligibility checklist for the AFCT PER MCO 1230.5C

- Submitted request electronically via the Navy College Management Information System (NCMIS) at <https://myeducation.netc.navy.mil>.
- Marines must submit requests to their first O-5 level commander by providing the email address of either the commander Officer or their designated "By direction" representative within NCMIS.
- Upon approval, an electronically signed authorization letter will populate in the Marine's NCMIS profile.
- Marines must then coordinate with their installation Education Center to schedule the retest.
- Waivered retest requests will be automatically routed to HQMC MPA for final determination.
- All preparatory requirements for waivered retest requests are no longer required.
- Marines will receive automated email updates throughout the approval and routing process.
- Authorization Expiration. Approved requests in NCMIS are valid for 90 days. Marines must complete testing within this window no extensions will be granted. All hard-copy authorization requests dated prior to this message remain valid.
- Submit requests or questions to MPA at smb_manpower_msab_testing@usmc.mil. Or visit your education office for assistance.
- Waiver requests were routed to Headquarters Marine Corps (HQMC) Test Control (MPA) following O-5 endorsement.
